Kindergarten registration is an important and exciting step in your child's educational experience. This letter will provide you with information and materials to help you navigate the registration process.

Our online pre-registration is now available. Please complete the [Google Form](#) to begin the registration process. This form will take you approximately 15-30 minutes to complete and **MUST** be completed prior to Friday, January 22, 2021. A follow up email will be forthcoming in January regarding in-person or virtual registration in order to collect the required documents.

Kindergarten entrance requirements include the items listed below. **Any information that is not available by the registration date will be due by Friday, June 4th, 2021.**

- Official birth certificate (with raised seal and issued from a government agency)
- Two items to indicate proof of residency:
 - Mandatory:** Driver's License/Photo ID with address
 - Mandatory:** Utility bill, Tax bill, Lease, Purchase Contract, etc.
- Mandatory:** Student's recent [Physical Examination Form](#) (within past 6 months)
- Mandatory:** Student's immunization records
- Complete online Registration Form which includes:
 - Health Questionnaire
 - Readiness Survey
 - Gifted & Talented inventory

I look forward to meeting you in the spring as the Class of 2024 begins their educational journey in the Fair Haven Public Schools.
